
- Quality not quantity each action needs detailed information on the why, who, what, and when of the action.
- Stronger connection between the risk assessment and mitigation strategy
- More specific, achievable actions
  - Specific projects, in specific locations, in a specific timeframe
  - Focus on socially vulnerable populations and underserved communities


- 2019 Projects
  - If a project is not finished and still a priority, include in 2024 HMP
  - Remove general projects or make more specific
  - Remove ongoing capabilities like maintenance or annual outreach
- Diverse actions
  - You need at least <u>one action per hazard</u> <u>of concern</u>. Think about actions that can cover multiple hazards.
  - If you have critical facilities in the floodplain, need an action addressing the facility
  - If you have RL/SRL properties, need an action to mitigate those properties
  - Include a variety of action types (e.g., plans, floodproof critical facilities, outreach programs, etc.)


